## Parking on Campus

### On-street Pay and Display parking spaces

- There are on-street Pay and Display parking space in and around the Clifton Campus.
- You can park for up to 30 minutes free of charge using a pay and display ticket or pay to park for up to three hours. In some areas, you can park for longer than three hours. This will be shown on the signs next to the parking place and on the pay and display machine

### Public car parks

- There are a number of [Public car parks](#) such as [Trenchard Street](#) in close proximity to the Clifton Campus.

### Disabled visitors

- Visitors in possession of a local authority Blue Badge can use the rights they are given on public highways

## University of Bristol

Users of university car parks on Clifton campus should pay special attention as [the alignment of the CAZ boundary](#) means daily charges will apply to non-compliant vehicles using some car parks e.g. Old Park Hill, but not others (subject to the access route taken).

### Travelling to Bristol and around the UK

- [Travelwest](#) has a national journey planner which you can use to plan journeys around Bristol. The planner allows you to look at travelling by foot, by bike, by bus, by train and by car.
- [Traveline](#) offers a similar services and you can also contact Traveline by calling 0871 200 22 33.
- Maps of Bristol and Bristol City Centre showing cycle routes and walking routes are produced by Bristol City Council under their Better By Bike banner. There is a great online [cycle route planner](#) available or you can [request a paper map](#) from them.
- [Traffic England](#) provides current traffic conditions on England's motorways and major A roads.

### Bus Services to the University include:

The **72 bus** service from Bristol Temple Meads train station. These run a combined frequency of every 15 minutes at peak times and stop at Tyndall Avenue on the University campus. The journey takes about 20 to 30 minutes.

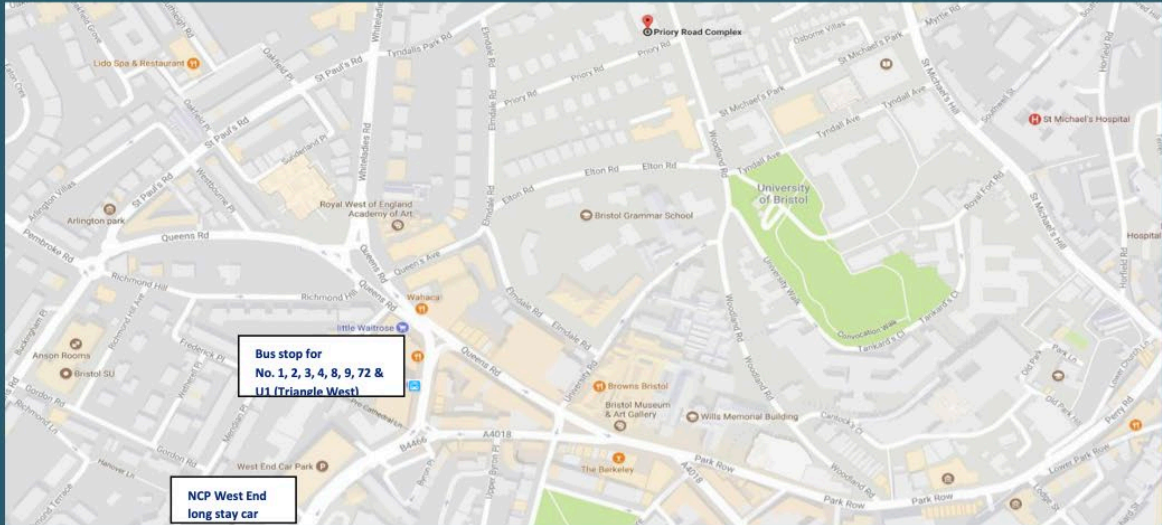
The **8 bus** service from Bristol Temple Meads train station. This runs at least every 10 minutes at peak times and stops by The Berkeley pub on Queen's Road, opposite the Wills Memorial Building, before heading towards the Richmond Building (Students' Union) and Clifton village. The journey takes about 20 to 30 minutes.

The **1, 2, 2a, 3, 4, 5 and 77 bus** services. These all stop in the Park Street, Triangle, Whiteladies Road area, two minutes walk from the University

The Bristol Unibus service. This connects the Stoke Bishop halls of residences with the University campus and city centre.

### Bus services:

U1 – The UniBus service runs term-time only, from the city centre directly into the Stoke Bishop campus.  
1/2 - Services run from opposite Station Approach Road (outside the Reckless Engineer pub) by Bristol Temple Meads rail station and the city centre.  
3/4 - Services run from the city centre.  
8/9/72 – Services run from Bristol Temple Meads rail station and the city centre.

For all the above bus services ask for the Triangle West.

### By Train:

Temple Meads is the closest train station. Bus services 8, 9 & 72 run from Temple Meads. Alternately you can walk down Temple Approach and take buses 1 or 2 from outside the Reckless Engineer pub (ask for the top of Park Street which is across the road from Wills Memorial Building).

There is no parking available at the Humanities Complex. Street parking is a mix of local resident's (9am–5pm Mon-Fri on a permit basis) and pay and display bays which allow parking up to 3 hours. There is a long stay NCP car park nearby on Jacobs Wells Road, BS8 1EH.
